

How to CE mark your products? Online or not? You choose!

First, do you know what CE marking is?

CE marking (CE mark) is an identification on a product that verifies its safeness, performance, and compliance with the European regulations for trade within the EU zone. CE marking is a complex, expensive, prolonged and sometimes very confusing process for manufacturers.

CE marking process in general

If you are a manufacturer and want to sell your product in one of the EU countries, then you will have to undertake the CE marking process. However, the CE mark is not required for all products on the market, only for those that fall under one of the mandatory 24 European regulatory directives.



So, in case your product needs to be CE marked, you need to complete the following 6 steps.

Online CE marking with CE Check



And you will ask "Is it possible?" The answer is "Yes, with **CE Check!**".

1 step: Directives

Hire a legal consultant to help you check if the CE mark directives apply to your product. If you see that your product falls under any CE mark directive, this means that you need to CE mark it.



2 step: Standards

Search among approximately 5000 harmonized standards and identify which one(s) apply to your product.

1 step:

No consultants are required! You can do it by yourself.



All you will have to do is to answer a few questions about your product's features. Afterwards, CE Check will go through all CE mark directives and list only those necessary to get your product CE mark approved. CE Check will also help you find the correct standards for your product out of thousands of possible ones.

3 step: Testing

Check if you need to test and certify your product by a third party. Some products, not all, need to pass a testing performed and approved by third party test laboratory to ensure their safeness and CE compliance.



4 step: Notified body

Depending of what directives your product should apply with, you might need a Notified body to review your documentation and technical file. A Notified body is the entity/organization which has been approved by the European Commission to assess whether a product placed on the market meets the applicable CE requirements or not.



5 step:

Create and maintain a technical file with all of your product's documentation, demonstrating your product's CE compliance. The technical file usually needs to be archived for 10 years after the last product has been sold.



6 step:

Create a Declaration of Conformity and affix your product's CE mark. The Declaration of Conformity certifies the compliance of your product. It represents your acknowledgment that you are solely responsible for the CE mark compliance of your product and the legal obligations.



Do you know how to do it?

2 step:

Consequently, CE Check will show you if you need to test your product. Consequently, if you need to test your product, CE Check will help you to do it in one of our partners' labs.



3 step:

We will assist you in the creation and maintenance of a technical file with all of your product's CE mark compliance documentation. Upload your documents to our service and we will store and archive them for you.



4 step:

We will help you! We will automatically create a correct Declaration of Conformity for you, verifying the CE compliance of your product.



That's all! After completing all steps, your product will be CE marked, and you could sell it in the EU zone.
